It has been good for me to apply my dance therapy skills with a different population. We explore their struggles through looking at the mind, body and soul to find holistic healing. I will continue to work with women until the end of 2012. Over the past couple of months I have enjoyed visiting the women in our community and trying to apply the CPM in our new community. I am burdened for the local women around us and believe we will see great changes this year. Thanks for your great friendship and partnership in the Kingdom".




WHO'S WHO ON THE ICDFF BOARD?
