Through the support of the ICDF-Foundation it became possible for me to accept the invitation to teach at the International Christian Dance Conference in Puerto Rico this year 2013.

I am very grateful to have had this possibility and thank all those who made it possible a lot! I felt very encouraged by this support, since other than that there is none over here yet.

I was teaching a workshop with a dance / choreography of Kyrie from Misa Criolla. It was contemporary dance to a music style that was not used otherwise at the conference. The workshop was visited by about 80 Students.

We had meetings to share reports of the different countries and it was so good to share the concerns of each other and then praying together, blessing and listening to Jesus and the Holy Spirit.
